It features a one-hotpot-per-person form of sanitary serving and caters to customers of different taste by providing individualized hotpot soup of non-spicy, moderately spicy and highly spicy ingredients. The restaurant is located at the heart of one of the brightest spots in Chongqing, Hongyadong (pictured above), where after savoring the great food one can enjoy an extravagant show reflecting the 3000-year-old Chongqing Bayu culture, sample mouthwatering local delicacies, window shop hundreds of stores stocked with art crafts and other merchandises, or leisurely watch the night view of the Jialing River.</p>

It entered the world cultural heritage list of UN in 1999. On the way back, we will visit the brand new campus D of Chongqing University. After this, interested attendees may go on one of the cruise ships for a tour of the three gorges and the three-gorge dam, or visit other scenic spots in the surrounding areas of Chongqing, on their own expenses (NAS'08 will assist in tour arrangements).</p>
