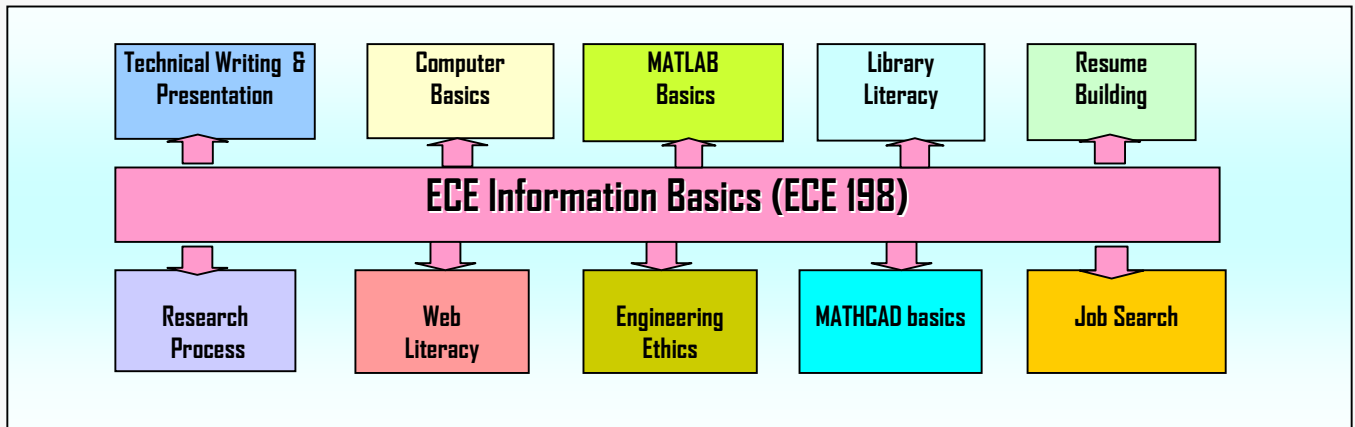
COURSE GOAL
